

Why do some schools show a progression rate to third level of over 100%?

The third-level progression percentages listed on these pages relate to the total number of 2021 college registrations from each school (including those who completed the Leaving Cert cycle prior to 2021) as a proportion of the number of 2021 Leaving Certs registered at the school. When the number who completed the Leaving Cert cycle in previous years and began college this year is greater than the number of "sits" calculated by the Department of Educa-

tion, it can result in a figure that is over 100 per cent in some cases. Due to legal provisions restricting the supply of certain data the progression rates relating solely to candidates who sat the Leaving Cert in 2021 are not available.
